

III Regional Parliamentary Workshop on Gender Aspects of Human Security in the framework of the SEE Women MP Exchange

In the framework of the SEE Women MPs Exchange Project, the third regional Parliamentary Workshop was held in Zagreb on 20 November 2006. Women MPs and representatives from civil society of ten SEE countries gathered together to discuss “ Gender aspects of human security”, focussing on four main issues:

- i. Violence against women, in particular in the framework of the Council of Europe pan-European campaign to combat this phenomenon.
- ii. Women’s participation in decision-making, with particular reference to UN Resolution 1325
- iii. Women refugees, IDPs and asylum seekers
- iv. Economic/job insecurity
