I am pleased to invite you to the thirteenth meeting of Working Table II will be held in Belgrade, on Monday 29 May 2006. In line with our normal practice, this meeting will be held on the same day as the plenary meetings of Working Tables I and III.

The Regional Table meeting of the Stability Pact will take place the following day 30 May and will report on the outcome of each of the Working Table meetings as well as taking decisions on further developing the Stability Pact into a more regionally owned co-operation framework, while safeguarding the achievements of the Pact and ensuring sustainability of the regional co-operation processes initiated under its auspices.

Our Working Table II meeting will be structured around two issues – the establishment of a single free trade agreement in the region and its contribution to improving the economic climate and secondly progress being made under WTII to streamline our initiatives and enhance regional ownership.

Having in mind short duration of our meeting (2hrs and 30 minutes), we will not have time for statements of a general nature. Should you wish to provide additional information on your country or organization's activities in relation to WT II initiatives, please forward written statements and/or reports to the Stability Pact office in advance of the meeting. These will be then placed on the special WT II meeting webpage and can also be made available at the meeting in Belgrade alongside the progress reports from each of our initiatives.
