On behalf of the Chair and Co-Chair of Working Table III, I would like to invite you to the twelfth meeting of the Working Table, which will be held on Tuesday 15th November next in Prague, where the Czech government will also be hosting the meeting of the Regional Table on the 16th November.

The Working Table III meeting will take place between 16:00 and 18:30 in the conference centre of the Hotel Diplomat.

As mentioned in the letter of the Special Coordinator, the Stability Pact has currently undertaken a serious strategy analysis. Considering the importance of the Justice and Home Affairs area for the countries of the region on their path towards European and Euro-Atlantic integration the meeting of the Working Table III in Prague will dedicate most of its agenda to the fight against organised crime, corruption and to the regional cooperation among the law enforcement and judiciary. Also, topics like Defence conversion and Disaster Preparedness and Prevention will be briefly discussed.

The priority of all the initiatives within the Working Table III, as for the entire Stability Pact initiatives for the coming years, has to be to ensure the sustainability of the regional ownership process. We expect to have concrete inputs from both the regional and international partners during our sessions in Prague.
